Professor Cakmakci is also intensely engaged in patient safety, healthcare quality, and organizational aspects of healthcare and health systems administration. The first, pioneering patient safety organization was founded by him at Acibadem in the year 2000. He is also leading the way in patient safety issues throughout the country, and was chairman in of the “First International Patient Safety Congress” in Turkey in March 2007. He is co-founder of the Turkish Society for Quality Improvement in Healthcare.

Because he has spent more than 15 years of work life in top executive positions at Hacettepe University, the private Acibadem Health Care Group, and Anadolu Medical Centre, he has tremendous experience in designing, and operating of healthcare facilities, and academical

knowledge in quality, safety, and organizational aspects of health care in public as well as in private healthcare systems.

Dr. Cakmakci is chairman of the board of directors of the Argüden Governance Academy, which is a non-profit initiative dedicated to improve governance quality in public, non-profit, private, and international organizations to create sustainable value for institutions and society.

After being a council member for ten years, he served as the president of the Surgical Infection Society-Europe between 2008-2009. He is a fellow of both, the American College of Surgeons and the American College of Physician Executives.

On the other hand, he is also co-founder and elected first president of the Turkish Ethics and Reputation Society (TEID), which was founded in May 2010 as a non-profit organization aiming to develop and encourage adherence to universally recognized business ethics principles and disseminating those in the business environment.
